BILLS ON THIRD CONSIDERATION

SENATE 67

An Act amending Title 34 (Game) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in hunting and furtaking, repealing provisions relating to hunting on Sunday prohibited, providing for hunting on Sunday and further providing for the offense of trespass on private property while hunting and for hunting on Sunday without written **permission.** (Senators LAUGHLIN and others)

SENATE

An Act amending the act of June 2, 1915 (P.L.736, No.338), known as the Workers' Compensation Act, in interpretation and definitions, further providing for definitions; and, in liability and compensation, providing for compensation for post-traumatic stress **injury.** (Senators BARTOLOTTA and others)

SENATE 645

An Act amending Title 53 (Municipalities Generally) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in general provisions, providing 686 for ten-year limitation for acquiring title to vacant land for gardens in cities of the first class. (Senators HUGHES and others)

SENATE

667

An Act amending the act of December 19, 1988 (P.L.1262, No.156), known as the Local Option Small Games of Chance Act, in games of chance, providing for payment; and abrogating a **regulation.** (Senators ROBINSON and others)

An Act amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, establishing the Pennsylvania Award for Student Success Scholarship Program. (Senators J. WARD and others)

An Act providing for the abrogation of regulations relating to the CO2 Budget Trading Program. (Senators YAW and others) 6

SENATE 1087

An Act amending Title 34 (Game) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in Pennsylvania Game Commission, further providing for organization of commission; in game or wildlife protection, further providing for report to commission officer and for surrender of carcass to commission officer; in hunting and furtaking, further providing for the offense of trespass on private property while hunting; and, in special licenses and permits, providing for agriculture access permit list. (Senators ROTHMAN and others)

An Act amending Title 63 (Professions and Occupations (State Licensed)) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in powers and duties, providing for criminal history background checks. (Senators BOSCOLA and others)

SENATE 1172

An Act amending the act of February 19, 1980 (P.L.15, No.9), known as the Real Estate Licensing and Registration Act, in definitions, further providing for definitions; in application of the act and penalties, further providing for exclusions; and, in duties of licensees, providing for right to cancel sales agreements or sales contracts for wholesale transactions. (Senators STEFANO and others)

SENATE 219

An Act amending the act of December 13, 1988 (P.L.1190, No.146), known as the First and Second Class County Property Tax Relief Act, further providing for short title, for definitions, for deferral or exemption authority and for retroactive application. (Senators COSTA and others)

BILLS ON SECOND CONSIDERATION

SENATE 501

An Act amending Title 53 (Municipalities Generally) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in municipal authorities, further providing for definitions, providing for public safety authorities and further providing for purposes and powers. (Senators BAKER and others)

SENATE 525

An Act amending the act of February 14, 2008 (P.L.6, No.3), known as the Right-to-Know Law, in agency response, providing for vexatious requester. (Senators DUSH and others)

SENATE *577*

An Act amending the act of October 13, 2010 (P.L.506, No.72), known as the Construction Workplace Misclassification Act, further 1156 providing for definitions, for improper classification of employees and for criminal penalties; providing for private right of action; and further providing for administrative penalties, for retaliation for action prohibited, for availability of information and for funding. (Senators KANE and others)

HOUSE

An Act amending Title 53 (Municipalities Generally) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in neighborhood blight reclamation and revitalization, further providing for definitions and providing for vacant and blighted property registration; and **imposing penalties.** (Representatives TWARDZIK and others)

SENATE

An Act amending Title 26 (Eminent Domain) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in procedure to condemn, providing for 1566 advanced notice to condemnee; and, in just compensation and measure of damages, providing for compensation for loss of goodwill of business or farm operation. (Senators DUSH and others)

SENATE 841

An Act amending the act of August 15, 1961 (P.L.987, No.442), known as the Pennsylvania Prevailing Wage Act, further providing for definitions, for specifications, for prevailing wage and for duty **of secretary.** (Senators FARRY and others)

SENATE

1026

An Act amending the act of December 19, 1975 (P.L.604, No.173), entitled "An act to facilitate the use of electronic funds transfer systems by providing that credits to accounts in financial institutions designated by recipients shall satisfy legal requirements for payments by cash or checks," further providing for electronic funds transfers, for consumer protections and for payroll card **accounts.** (Senators MILLER and others)

SENATE 1108

An Act amending Title 38 (Holidays and Observances) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in veteran recognition, 1462 providing for K9 Veterans Day. (Senators BROWN and others)

An Act amending the act of December 20, 2000 (P.L.724, No.99), known as the Municipal Code and Ordinance Compliance Act, 2286 further providing for definitions and for compliance requirement. (Representatives MALAGARI and others)

RESOLUTION

SENATE

A Concurrent Resolution petitioning the Congress of the United States to call a Convention for proposing amendments pursuant to 511 Article V of the Constitution of the United States limited to proposing amendments that impose fiscal restraints on the Federal Government, limit the power and jurisdiction of the Federal Government and limit the terms of office for its officials and for **members of Congress.** (Senators DUSH and others)
